

TWISTER

The Twister is a comparatively young boat but her fame is already world-wide. Although this is largely due to her many awards in International Competitions, a feature of the Boat is the comfort and adaptability for the family cruising man.

The Twister has been adjudged the most successful small cruiser/racer design of the past 2 decades.

Below deck there is a full 6' headroom and the spacious 4 berth accommodation is exceptionally comfortable. There are 2 berths in the saloon and a double cabin forward. A quarter berth may be incorporated in the chart table space to provide a fifth berth. Lining the saloon are convenient shelves and lockers and there is a large table which folds neatly out of the way when not in use. Dividing the saloon from the forward cabin are 2 roomy cupboards and lockers with dual purpose doors. Also in this area is a separate Blake toilet.

Aft of the saloon is the galley. This includes a fully gimbed three-burner stove, sink with trap over and a Formica work top. Most important, there are plenty of hooks, plate racks and storage space. Facing the galley is a full-sized chart table with a really practical working area.

The majority of deck fittings are of stainless steel by Lewmar, all supplied as standard, including pulpit, pushpit, roller reefing, etc. Mast and spars are alloy, anodised and sound-deadened, with choice of colour and all fittings and rigging in stainless steel.
